Mission will give appointment on first come first serve basis and applicant will be required to present at the camp premises with required documents on the appointment date and time.

- All, who wish to apply for NVR at the camp is requested to send a copy (in PDF format/scanned copy) of the electronically submitted visa application form along with required documents (proof of nationality, proof of payment etc.) at email consular.canberra@mofa.gov.bd by 21 June 2021. Mission will give appointment on first come first serve basis and applicant will be required to present at the camp premises with required documents (hard copy) on the appointment date and time.
